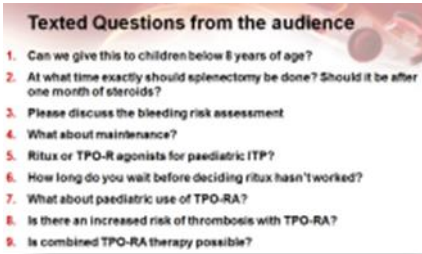


- Choose from a range of keypads depending on requirements and budgets.

How to capture your data

Multiple choice questions are the most common use of ARSs but there are many other uses;



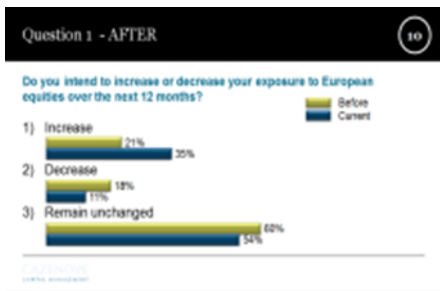
1. TEXTING. Using a keypad, send questions & comments prior to Q&A sessions. When the Q&A session begins, presenters will already have a choice of questions to respond to. Questions can be moderated before being displayed live (Plus & Engage Plus keypads only).



2. FEEDBACK. Greener alternative to feedback forms and saves hours of manual data entry. Use keypads to collect data which is then available in a variety of reports. (See next page). Displaying results graphs is optional.



3. QUIZZES & TESTS. The system keeps score of how many correct answers each delegate gives. Display either team or individual scores instantly on a scoreboard.



4. COMPARISON/ BEFORE & AFTER Ask the same question at the start and end of a presentation and compare results



5. RANKING. Delegates can rank a number of options/ people/ items in order of preference.



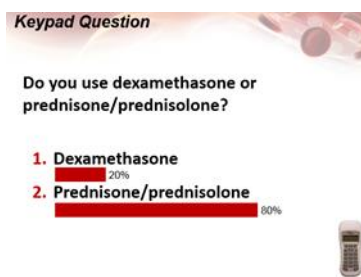
6. VOTING. Frequently used at awards events and AGMs. Display results as percentage or actual vote numbers

Demographic Questions & Data

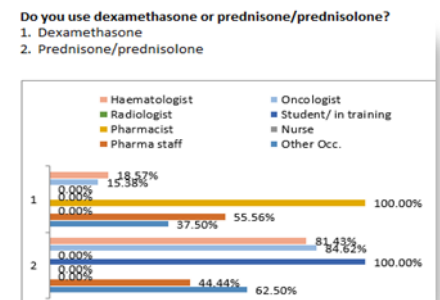
Demographic questions allow the audience's responses to be broken down in to categories. This data is presented in a report and used for post-event analysis



1 Ask the audience a demographic question



2 Ask the audience a multiple choice question



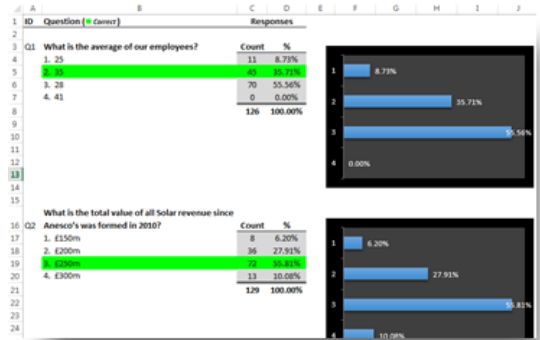
3 Breakdown the answers by the demographics for post-event analysis

Data Reports - Get the data you want from the audience

Our polling software comes with a report function. This allows all data collected to be presented as reports in Excel and Word for post-event analysis

Reports are created after presentations to view all data that has been collected. They show every keypad/ delegate response by individual, demographic group and entire audience. There is also a report to show every question and comment when texting function has been used

Reports can be created immediately after data has been collected or any time after.
