Technical Details

Container capacity: 20 I (made in UV stabilised polyethylene)

Hose: 1.2 m in length

Dimensions (mm): 390x190x575 (LxWxH) Packaging dimensions (mm): 390x210x580 (LxWxH)

Weight: 4.2 kg (empty)

Filling

Open the cap and fill the tank using approved distilled or deionised water carefully through the filter in the tank opening, The liquid level must never exceed the bottom of the filter

• Close the cap.

Preparation for use

- Slip one arm into the strap next to the pump arm, and lift the sprayer onto one shoulder.
- Take the other shoulder strap by the free hand and hook it over the other arm.
- Please see diagram for arrangement.

Instructions for use in filling batteries.

- With the filling pistol valve lever in the closed position, pump until a certain resistance can be felt.
- Place the pistol head into the vent of the cell, ensuring that the correct spacer has been used for the cell type.
- Open the valve lever and continue pumping to maintain a steady pressure. During filling this about will be one pump every one to two seconds.
- When the correct level is reached the water flow will stop automatically.
- Stop pumping and remove the pistol from the cell.
- Shake the pistol head slightly to break the water meniscus and continue to the next cell.
- Please read the data sheet supplied with the filling system before using it for the first time.

Safety Notes For You and the Battery

For your Health and Safety

- Use only approved distilled or deionised water to top up.
- Alkali and Acid do not mix! Use separate equipment for Acid and Alkali batteries.
