We take this opportunity to introduce you to the wide range of natural stone products available from our quarries in the Cotswolds.

# **Building Stone**

This range of stone, suitable for both new build and restoration projects, is produced as a rough dressed building stone and will require some dressing on site. Usually supplied 115 to 125mm on bed, with face heights ranging typically between 75 to 150mm and random lengths.

- BROCKHILL GREY
- TINKERS BARN (low rise)
- COTSWOLD CREAM
- COTSWOLD GOLD

They can be supplied individually or mixed to provide a variation in both size and colour. Available as random, coursed, tipped or in bags.

#### **DRYSTONE WALLING**

Supplied random, "as dug", with thickness varying between 25 to 115mm. As a rule of thumb, you should get 2 to 2.5 face metres of walling to the tonne. Available in one type:

### **NATURAL STONE COTSWOLD ROOFING SLATES**

From our Tinkers Barn quarry and supplied for diminishing courses between 150mm (6 inch) to 450mm (18 inch) in length, with random widths.

A full breakdown of sizes, delivered on a shrink-wrapped pallet, is available on request.

#### **CRAZY PAVING**

Supplied from our Tinkers Barn quarry, with random widths and lengths, it is relatively flat and very durable. Thickness varies, but is generally between 25 to 50mm and is sold by the square metre.
