## Product Information Sheet

### Cotswold Roofing Slates

We take this opportunity to introduce Cotswold Stone quarries as a supplier of natural stone Cotswold roofing slates. From our Tinkers Barn quarry we can produce over 50 old roofing square (465 M2) per month, with further capacity available.

Our slates cost **£1,500.00** per old roofing square (9.3 M2) and are sold by the standard pallet, which is three quarters of an o.r.s. Each pallet will cover 7 M2 of roof, including laps. Once on site, all the slates should be unpacked and sorted into sizes, with the roof then battened to suit the stone on the ground.

Specific lengths can be produced to a batten gauge supplied to us at **£1,700.00** per o.r.s. Any special slates, such as wider slates for swept valleys or mitred hips, should be charged at this higher rate. Delivery charges are not included in the above prices.

Each pallet consists of approximately 330 slates between 6 to 12 inches inclusive, 70 between 13 to 17 inches and 25 eighteen-inch slates.

Thickness can vary, although our slates are highly regarded for their relative flatness and ease of laying. Widths are on average as follows:

Six to nine inches long	- 5 inches
Ten to twelve	- 6 inches
Thirteen to fifteen	- 6 to 8 inches
Sixteen to eighteen	- 8 to 11 inches

This breakdown has been developed with assistance from specialised Cotswold slate roofers to give a full range of coursed slates suitable for most jobs.

Our slates are sold on a proforma invoice basis and must be paid for one week prior to delivery, at which time the slates can be inspected at the quarry. This approach enables us to ensure that:

- Our price of **£1,500.00** ex works is competitive
- We can supply both quality and quantity with confidence.
