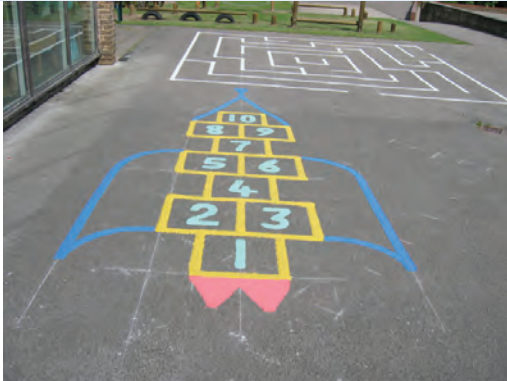


Playground Markings



Playground markings are an essential part of play learning for children. We lay any shape or game that you require.

Traditional playground games such as hopscotch, snakes and ladders, number squares, battleships grid, numbered snake/ladder, activity circuit, throwing target, A to Z or 1 to 10 lines, are the most popular shapes, but we can lay any shape or pattern.

Thermoplastic is the most cost effective material as paint has a much shorter life.

Thermoplastic markings are laid using hand formed or pre formed material. Hand formed material is much more cost effective and has much greater flexibility as markings can be altered in size or shape on the day of laying to fit your exact needs.

School logo's can be enlarged and reproduced to add to the appearance of the school.

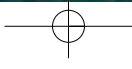
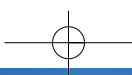

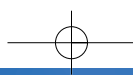

We give advice on layouts if required.

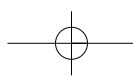

Road Markings



White lines were first laid in the UK at Ashford in Kent in 1914, since then markings have become an essential part of road safety.



Thermoplastic is the most widely used material although other materials are available.

Various grades of material are in general use, to meet daytime luminance, night time retroreflectivity, skid resistance and wetnight reflectivity.



Yellow lines are used for parking restrictions, hatched areas, bus stops, School Keep Clear areas and rumble strip markings.

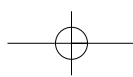

We also lay coloured non slip surfacing to walkways and forklift areas giving an anti slip surface even when wet.

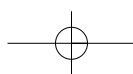

Anti Skid Surfacing Hot and Cold Applied



Anti skid surfacing using thermoplastic and 2 pack epoxy resin base are provided and laid.

We lay HAPAS type 1 material to clause 924.

Red coloured anti skid for warning areas, splitter islands. Speed roundels, sharks teeth are popular in village gateways and school approaches.

Buff or grey anti skid is used to provide high friction surfacing areas on approaches to junctions and traffic lights.

RMS Stoneways Stonetop Resin Bonded Stone



RMS Stoneways Stonetop is a resin bonded stone surfacing that can be laid onto concrete or tarmac. The resin is mixed, spread and the chosen stone is broadcast on top. When the resin has set, excess stone is swept away leaving a non slip, aesthetically pleasing surfacing, that can be trafficked and will give a durable watertight finish. The base resins can be tinted to further enhance the appearance.

Popular uses are for access roads, driveways, footpaths, walkways and landscaped areas, where a natural stone finish is required.

Designs or patterns can be incorporated using different coloured stone to suit your requirements.

RMS Stoneways Stonetop can be laid onto existing solid surfaces.

RMS Stoneways Stoneblend Resin Bound Stone



RMS Stoneways Stoneblend is a resin bound stone surfacing.

Many different colours and sizes of stone are available, blends of stone are used to produce the finish you require.

Clear resin and natural stone are blended together and laid with a smooth troweled finish to give an attractive appearance.

We can also add a non-slip finish to the surface for pedestrian or trafficked areas.

Coloured glass is also used in highly decorative areas to give an enhanced appearance.

Tree pits are laid using larger stone, on top of an open substrate, the area then remains porous to allow plants to remain watered.

The major advantage of using Resin bonded stone for tree pits is that there are no loose stones, the area around the tree has an aesthetic appearance whilst remaining porous.
