Damages Caused by Floods in Thailand (NOTIFY: Flood 2nd)

Nitto Kohki group suffers damage caused by floods entailing the heavy rain in Thailand.
Please be advised that the current status of our sites in Thailand as follows,

1. Current Status of Sites

Due to water exposure in the Rojana Industrial Park in Ayutthaya, the following production facilities are partially damaged and the operation is temporarily suspended.

Rojana Industrial Park is now being dewatered. Expected walk-in date to the sites is after late December.

(1) Nitto Kohki (Thailand) Co., Ltd.

- Major operation of this site: Production of Linear piston compressors and pumps
- Number of employee: 89.

(2) Nitto Kohki Coupling (Thailand) Co., Ltd.

- Major operation of this site: Production of Couplings
- Number of employee: 84.

2. Current Status of Alternative Production

Production of couplings and compressors/pumps operated in Thailand is being transferred to Tochigi Nitto Kohki Co., Ltd., located in Tochigi prefecture, Japan.

Alternative production of Couplings in Tochigi Nitto Kohki has been started in November, and compressors/pumps will be started in December.
