A double skin tank that does not have 110% overflow capacity is classed as a "High specification PRIMARY container", it is not a bunded tank and may not be compliant.

CIRIA Report 163 defines secondary containment as a containment system that is capable of preventing the escape of material to aquatic environment in the event of failure of the primary storage container. It should be noted that a double skinned primary container will not in itself provide secondary containment.

If a tank is the primary container, then it should go into a bunded area. If it is not in a bunded area, then it does not comply when secondary containment is required.
