BOAS Steam, Hot Water & Dual Courses

Boiler Operative Accredited Training Scheme: Developed in association with the Combustion Engineering Association, GASTEC and Carbon Trust, these courses are designed to provide extensive knowledge of current legislative and environmental requirements. A Cochran course consists of a full programme of lectures, followed by an examination. Upon passing, delegates will be 'Certified Industrial Boiler Operative' (Cert IBO) or Management (Dip BOM) qualified and may use these designations after their name. Certification is valid for five years, though Cochran recommend refresher training be taken before this period expires.

Boiler Operation and Maintenance Course: Primarily aimed at Boiler Operators, Maintenance Staff, Plant Technicians and Engineers. The intensive course provides a thorough grounding in the everyday operation and maintenance of boilers, burners and auxiliary boiler equipment. Training also covers all relevant Health and Safety issues, fault identification and what to do in emergency situations with the ultimate aim of ensuring plant is operated safely, efficiently and economically.

Boiler Operation and Safety Awareness Course: Aimed primarily at those who are responsible for attending to boiler plant, but also useful for Health and Safety personnel and anyone else with a need for a comprehensive overall understanding of the efficient operation of boiler plant. The course covers a basic understanding of everyday operation and covers essential daily and weekly routines, boiler fittings, water treatment, combustion, emergencies and Health and Safety issues. The first half of the course is theory but the second half will take place in the boilerhouse. For that reason, many customers prefer to have the training at their own site so that the practical work is in the boilerhouse they operate.

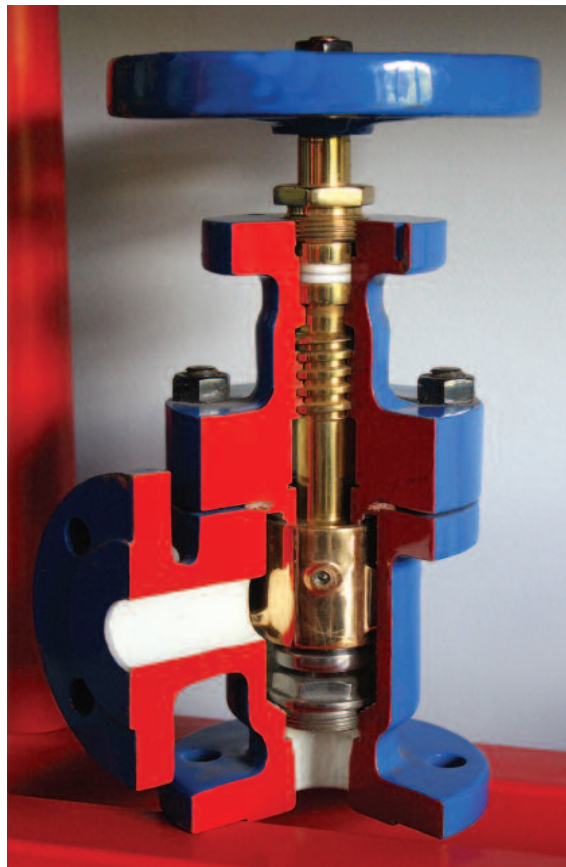
