

## **INDIVIDUAL CODE OF ETHICS**

In addition to their other duties, employees are responsible for:

- 1. Taking reasonable care for the health and safety of themselves and for that of other persons who may be affected by their conduct.
- 2. Co-operating with management to enable them to fulfill their statuary duty.
- 3. Observing all Company rules and instructions relating to health, safety and welfare in order to ensure not only their personal safety but also others.
- 4. Not intentionally or recklessly interfering with or misusing anything provided in the interest of health, safety or welfare at work.
- 5. Using the personal protective equipment, clothing or safeguards provided and Reporting immediately to their supervisor any equipment, conditions or Practices appearing likely to jeopardize health or safety
- 6. Conducting themselves in an orderly manner while on Company business and refraining from any form of horseplay.
- 7. Reporting all accidents to their supervisor whether or not any injury is sustained.
- 8. Being aware of the fire evacuation procedure, location of Air Horn points and fire extinguishers.
- 9. Maintaining a good standard of housekeeping at their place of work.
- 10. Using the correct tools or equipment for the work and reporting any damaged unsuitable or missing equipment to their supervisor.
- 11. As required, report to H & S Officer/Operations Manager.
