Co-operate with our clients on their sites to ensure that they are aware of any risks to their employees and other people posed by our activities, that we are aware of any risks to our employees from their activities, and that we comply with the requirements of relevant legislation.

Employees are reminded of their legal duties, whilst at work, to:

- take reasonable care of their own safety
- take reasonable care of the safety of others who may be affected by what they do or fail to do
- co-operate with the Company so that we can comply with our legal duties
- ensure we do not interfere with or misuse anything provided in the interests of health and safety.
