



SVG155 Sliding Doors — Near Blackburn

We were asked by the builder who was working for the client to quote for the supply and installation of the two doors shown. We met with the client and the builder during the build to explain the benefits of our triple track sliding doors. The client wanted to create the effect of an open corner which they achieved with the use of two sliding aluminium doors either side of the structural steel post.

The extension to form the new kitchen dining area is a contemporary design on an old theme — a Victorian house but the mix looks fantastic.

We used the SVG155 thermally broken aluminium triple track sliding door system to allow two thirds of the opening area with the two sliding panels stacking behind one fixed panel at the end. The corner post is steel to support the roof structure which we then had to clad internally and externally with powder coated aluminium to finish off the doors. The doors were manufactured to a none standard RAL colour as chosen by the client. One of the key criteria for the doors was to ensure that the finished floor level on the inside was as flush as possible yet retain the weathering capability of the track system. We worked with the builders to get the perfect end result.
